Service Learning Fellowship:

KidUnity's Service Fellowship is a selective program designed to inspire and support Los Angeles-based K-12 educators who are passionate about service learning and civics. The fellowships will help teachers pursue professional development opportunities, and/or design and implement their own service or civics based programs.

The KidUnity Service Fellowship will provide direct financial support for educators' professional development and curriculum development - including both domestic and international summer travel experiences. Teachers applying for professional development/travel programs should have a clear sense of how such programs will inform the creation of new service learning curriculum.

One expectation of the Fellowship is that recipients will implement a service learning program/project at their school in partnership with KidUnity. These programs are eligible to receive additional financial support from KidUnity.

Who is Eligible?

The Service Fellowship is open to all educators in Los Angeles schools who currently or plan to teach grades K-12.

Funding Amounts and Allowable Expenses:

Fellowships may support up to \$2,500, and can be used to cover either full or partial project expenses. Allowable expenses include but are not limited to program fees, transportation (e.g. airfare), living expenses (e.g. lodging, food), and project-related materials and supplies.

- A resume
- A brief summary of your proposed project. Include the name of the organization you will be working with, the goal of your project, and any key deliverables. Provide the geographic location in which you will be working, and the project timeframe. Also include the background, experience and skills you bring to the project and any initial ideas you have for service learning projects back at your home school;

• A budget for your project.

Applications are due February 1, 2019 at 5 p.m. Awards will be announced mid-March, 2019.
